1. Purpose / situation

At the May 2024 Board, Iain Bell reported that the Rapid Overview Dashboard would be reviewed to:

- 1) Bring more diversity and inclusion data into the Overview Dashboard.
- 2) Replace the Excess Mortality tab of the dashboard with Avoidable Mortality (some deaths under age 75 are defined as avoidable). This will provide a more stable indicator for monitoring of negative outcomes in the population of Wales by disease group.
- 3) Undertake a series of engagements with Board members to ensure indicators reflect key priorities.

2. Progress to Date

This month's dashboard has seen the following updates:

- Economic activity data (employment, unemployment and inactivity rates) have been updated in line with latest ONS data and methods and the split by sex has been added.
- Avoidable Mortality will replace Excess Mortality in early August 2024 (a link to the dashboard will be circulated when this update has been published).

3. Next Steps

Iain Bell and Louisa Nolan (Head of Data Science) will arrange meetings with Board members during August and September 2024 to seek views on development of the dashboard.
