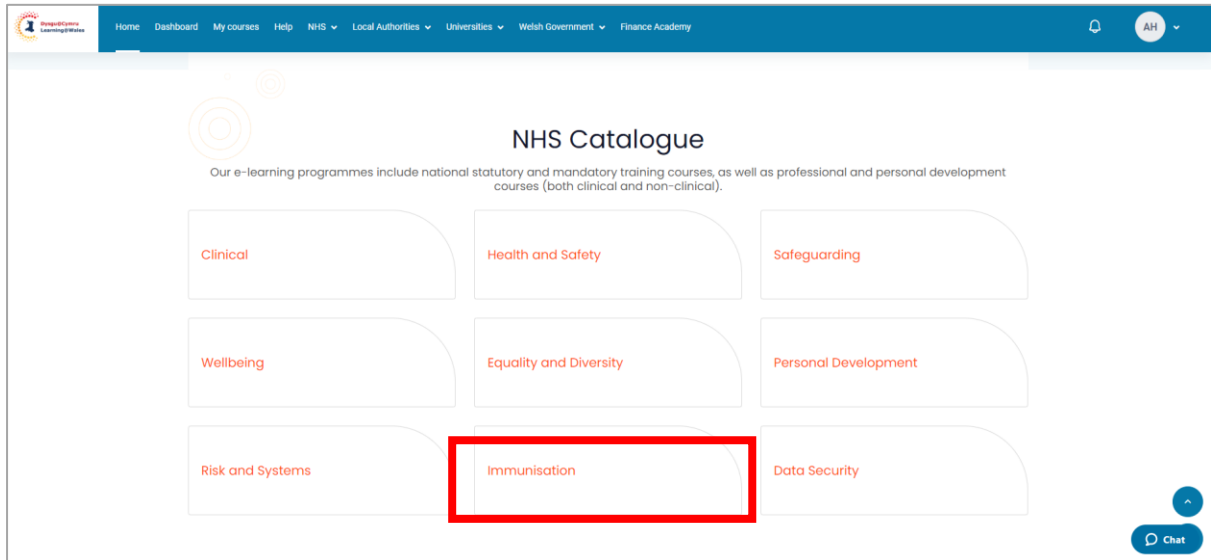

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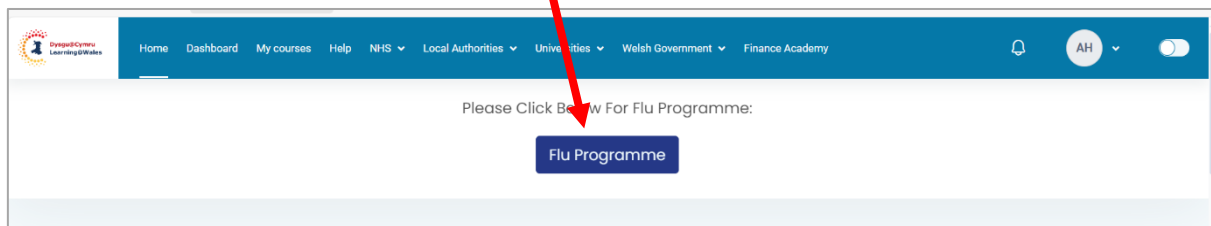
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Once logged in you will return to the homepage.

Please note: The Flu Clinical Update for Wales eLearning is made up of three modules:

Module 1: Core module - flu vaccination programme for 2025-26 season

Everyone needs to complete this core module. It outlines the key Welsh policy information that immunisers and those providing immunisation advice require for the 2025-26 flu season.

Once you have completed module 1 you can then complete the following modules. Only complete the modules that are appropriate for your role in immunisation:

Module 2: Adults flu vaccination module

Complete this module if your role includes advising on, and/or administering, flu vaccines to adults. It contains information specific to this age group.

Module 3: Children's flu vaccination module

Complete this module if your role includes advising on, and/or administering, flu vaccine to children. It contains information specific to this age group.

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You will be prompted to enter an enrolment key before you can start the module, see table below
