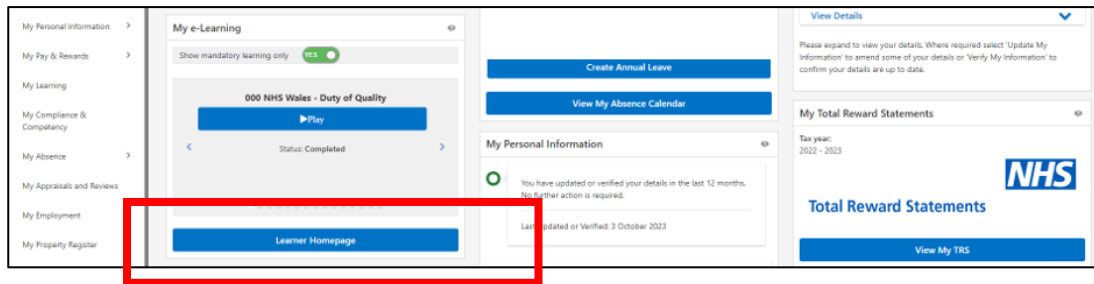


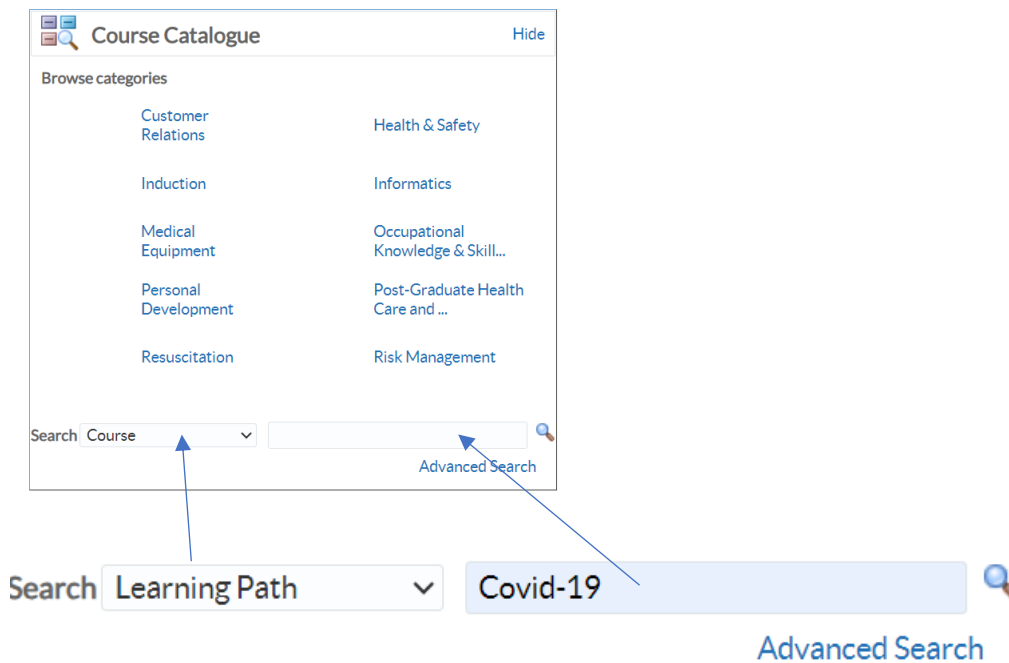
COVID-19 eLearning modules and assessments for Autumn 2024

How to access the eLearning on ESR

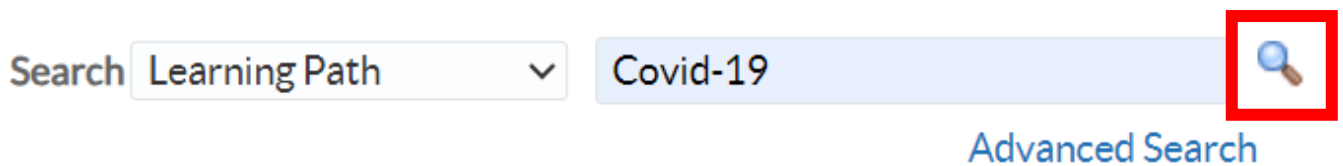
1. login to ESR, then click on Learning homepage



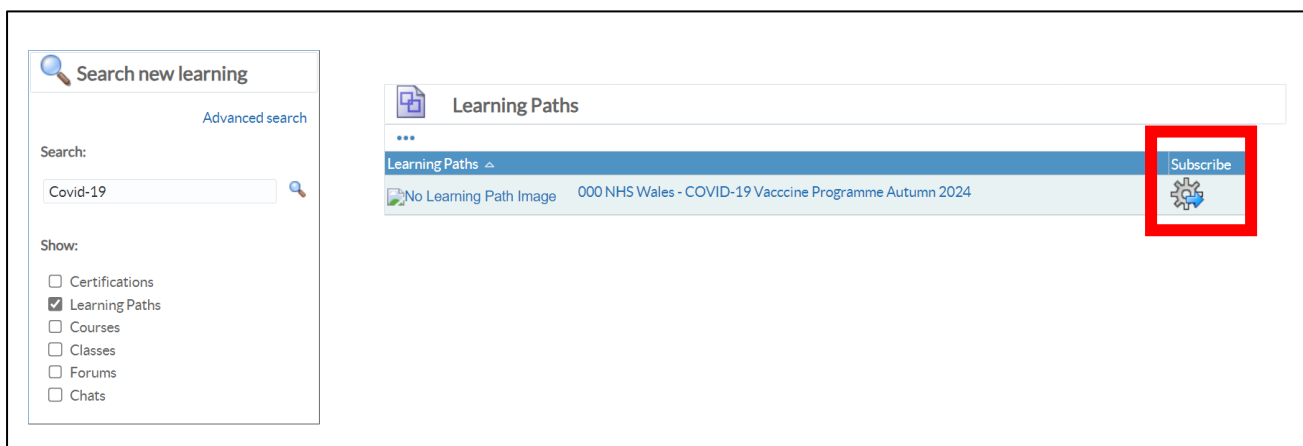
2. Once this screen is visible choose 'Learning Path' under course options and put Covid-19 in the search bar



3. Once the 'Learning Path' selection has been made and 'Covid-19' has been typed in the search box, click on the magnifying glass icon



4. The module will be under the Learning Paths category. Click on the subscribe icon alongside the title: 000 NHS Wales – COVID – 19 Vaccination Programme Autumn 2024

Description

The COVID-19 eLearning modules and assessments have been updated to include the latest Green book content and meet the requirements for the autumn 2024 COVID-19 vaccination campaign.

There is one combined module covering the material for the vaccination of eligible adults and young people aged 12 and above.

- Module: 000 Autumn 2024 COVID-19 vaccination: mRNA vaccines for adults and young people
- Assessment: 000 Pfizer BioNtech Comirnaty JN.1 30mcg/dose mRNA COVID-19 vaccine

- Assessment: 000 Moderna Spikevax JN.1 50mcg/dose mRNA COVID-19 vaccine

There is also now just one combined module covering the material for the vaccination of eligible infants and children from 6 months to 11 years.

- Module: 000 COVID-19 vaccination: mRNA vaccines for children aged 6 months to 11 years
- Assessment: 000 Comirnaty JN.1 3 mcg/dose for children aged 6 months to 4 years
- Assessment: 000 Comirnaty JN.1 10mcg/dose for children aged 5 to 11 years

It is recommended that experienced staff undertake the updated eLearning modules and assessments for the vaccines(s) that they will be responsible for administering. It is also recommended that new COVID-19 vaccinators undertake the core eLearning before completion of the relevant vaccine specific modules. The core knowledge module has an in built assessment section and has also been updated for autumn 2024.
